

QUALIFICATIONS

You are eligible to enter the competition if your permanent home address is:

NC: within a fifty (50) mile radius of Charlotte or, if outside the 50 mile radius, you reside in a county west of I-77, or play in the CSYO or JYO.
SC: within York or Lancaster Counties, or play in the CSYO or JYO.

Senior Division: Open to 10th, 11th and 12th grade students.

Junior Division: Open to 7th, 8th and 9th grade students.

Grand prize winners from previous years are not eligible to compete in the same category. Entrants may compete in only one category each year.

The music selection must be memorized for competition and must be at least five but no longer than ten minutes in length unless pre-approved. Please call Donna Worstell at 704-540-4266 by October 24, 2009 if your selection does not meet this criteria.

Entrant must supply his/her own accompanist and provide three music copies with measures numbered for the judges. No recorded accompaniment permitted.

AWARDS

Seniors: A panel of judges will make any selections as to persons who will appear as soloists, Senior Grand Prize Winners, in the Youth Festival Concert with the Charlotte Symphony Orchestra in Spring 2011. At the sole discretion of the judges, a winner and an honorable mention may be chosen from four categories — piano, woodwinds/brass, strings and percussion.

Juniors: A panel of judges will make any selections as to persons who will appear as soloists, Junior Grand Prize Winners, in the CSYO Spring Concert in Spring 2011. At the sole discretion of the judges, a winner and an honorable mention may be chosen from three categories — piano, woodwinds/brass and strings.

It is not required that there be a winner in each category. Soloists will be chosen only if the judges feel that the contestant has the ability to perform with the appropriate orchestra.
