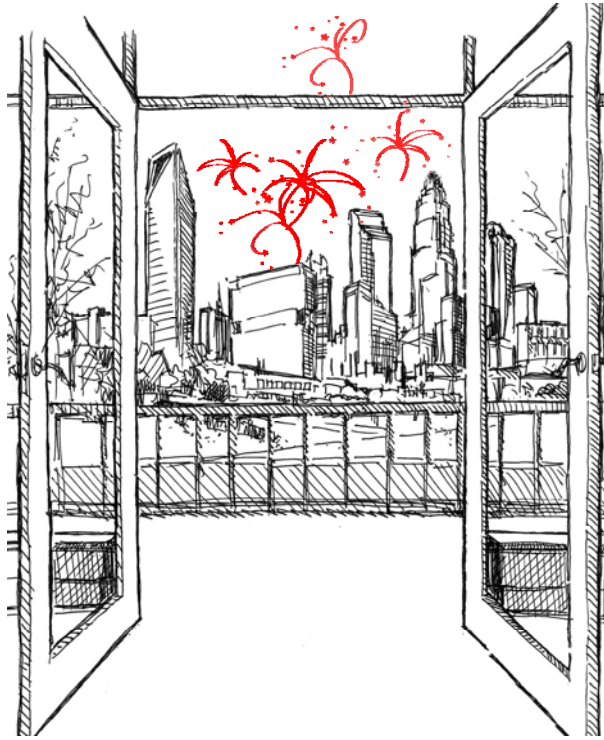
FROM YOUR PRESIDENT
